10 October 2020 PSYC 4165 Exam 1 Information Revised Fall 2020

The mid-term exam (Exam 1) will be administered via Canvas on Tuesday, 13 October 2020. You will have much more time to complete the whole exam than if it were to be given in the classroom from 11:10 to 12:25.

There are four separate parts to the exam. They are available on Canvas under "Quizzes.". Each part of the exam has a time limit of 40 minutes, which is approximately two to three times as long as is usually needed. The four parts of the exam may be done in any order although I recommend that you do them in numerical sequence. Once you start a section of the exam you must complete it before moving to another part. You must do all four parts of the exam to receive full credit.

The four parts of the exam will become accessible starting at 10:00 MST and ending at 13:00 MST). You have until 13:00 MST (1:00pm) to complete all four parts of the exam.

Part 1.1 Fifteen multiple choice questions (2 points each for total of 30 points)

Part 1.2 Five out of seven short-answer questions (10 points each for total 50 points)

Estimated time needed: 15 minutes Time limit on Canvas: 45 minutes

Part 1.3 Two diagram-labeling questions (20 points each for total of 40 points)

Estimated time needed: 10 minutes Time limit on Canvas: 45 minutes

Part 1.4 Answer one out of three longer essay questions (80 points total)

Estimated time needed: 20 minutes

Time limit on Canvas: 60
